

## Transition Wilmslow Transport Group

### 12/9/12 Notes and actions

#### 1. Introduction

TW Transport group welcomed new 20s Plenty campaigners  
FC gave brief introduction to how the campaign had started and what the purpose of the meeting was, namely to draw up a plan of how to take the campaign forward. Number of signatures so far: 43 from the Artisan market and the e-petition.

#### 2. Actions

- (a) Email / text people we know in Wilmslow and advertise where to sign the petition - all
- (b) Speak to neighbours and residents in own street - all
- (c) Order more bin stickers – very effective when the street is lined with them once a week/every two weeks and we believe people slow down just seeing those out (*post mtg note: £1.50 each + p&P £3.50*) – FC to ask PJ
- (d) Continue to take petition and stickers etc to Artisan market, events, School Christmas fairs – AM volunteered for future events. We will need volunteers periodically to man the stalls.
- (e) FC to confirm details of next Family Bike ride
- (f) Contact Cycletta – BF will ask SF
- (g) Contact High School – BF/FC
- (h) All write to Cllr Jones – Rod\* had mentioned one councillor he'd spoken to who said that if he received at least 6 letters re a particular topic he knew that that was an issue.
- (i) Find out about Cllr surgeries/open mtgs – CW
- (j) Write new 20s Plenty press release and take photo at market
- (k) FC to circulate draft leaflet –PM suggested we could produce postcard with Cllr's address/e-petition address to give people choice. Find out printing costs.
- (l) FC to circulate printable version of petition to have paper signatures
- (m) Donations welcome – thank you for contributions received so far.
